






Drop Off

Students that are dropped off prior to 8:55 am may enter the school building without an adult.

If your child is dropped off after 8:55 am, an adult must accompany your child to the main office and sign your child in to school.

We encourage all of our families to use properly marked bus loop when dropping of their children in order to ensure the safety of all of our students and families.

Dress Code

Students should wear sneakers to school everyday or have a pair available.

High shoes, flip flops, crocs, clogs, and open back sandals can be dangerous and are not allowed.

Children should be dressed in clothing that fits appropriately.

- No spaghetti straps or midriff shirts.
- Have your child dressed for the weather.
- Practice zipping, buttoning, and tying at home.
- **Label** all students clothing articles.
- **KINDERGARTENERS** need labeled shoe box with extra set of clothing




Bus Information
